Mental Health Associate/Trainee **Part-time Position**

Description:

Gain clinical experience in dyadic and family systems work through supporting the pivotal stages of a child's development and their early attachments with their caregivers by using a relationship-based approach. Provide direct services to children (under 7) with developmental delays and their families in agency, home, school or community settings for a minimum of 12 client hours each week. Participate in weekly group supervision each Friday from 12:00 - 2:00 and minimum of 1 hour each week of individual supervision, using a Reflective Supervision model. Provide case management of all assigned cases including note writing, report writing, managing client hours and communicating with other service providers. Participation in IFSP/IPP/IEP meetings for assigned cases and assist in program planning and community outreach efforts for the agency. Associates and trainees are paid per client hour. Mileage and drive time reimbursed.

Qualifications:

Minimum qualifications are current enrollment in graduate program or working toward licensure as well as Bachelor's or Master's degree in early childhood health or education related field. Must have a strong desire to work with children with special needs, two years' experience in early childhood services, including work with typical infants, toddlers and those with developmental delays. Candidate must also be able to demonstrate ability to work in a family centered, collaborative way with parents and professionals, have reliable transportation and be willing to drive throughout the San Fernando Valley. Minimum one year commitment and previous floor time training/experience desired.

Hours: Morning and/or Afternoon – depending on client needs
